CASM Selection Process

To be considered for selection into the CASM Foundation Year Program, applicants must attend both an audition and an interview.

CASM Audition

The audition provides an opportunity for you to show us your musical skills, knowledge and creativity, and your potential for ongoing musical development. It assists us to determine your suitability for the program, and is conducted in a relaxed and informal atmosphere.

Performing well at the audition will improve your chances of entering the CASM Foundation Year Program, so it is most important to ensure that you are well prepared.

Please prepare a minimum of **two pieces of music** to play and/or sing for your audition. You may choose to play and/or sing any music that you think will show the range and extent of your musical skills and potential. This could include songs or pieces of music, instrumentals, solos, improvisations, original songs or compositions, or scales, studies and exercises.

Please also bring anything that you think might be useful in showing us more about yourself and your music making including original songs, compositions, lyrics, stories, poetry, CDs, DVDs, YouTube videos, or other online examples. If you are a singer, you may wish to bring along your own backing tracks.

The audition is usually conducted by two academic staff members from CASM. The audition, including playing and/or singing and discussion, usually takes 20 minutes.

CASM Interview

The interview provides an opportunity for you to find out more about the CASM Foundation Year Program. It also enables us to find out more about your musical and academic background; your musical hopes and aims; and your overall suitability for undertaking tertiary level music studies through CASM. At the interview, we can give you a detailed overview of the program requirements, and you can let us know what you hope to gain from it. You will also find out more about CASM and the University, and the people you will work with if you are selected.

It is most important that you bring copies of the following to your interview, if you have not already submitted them with your application: a CV or resumé, personal or professional references, documents and information about your school and/or academic background (school/course results), written information about your work and/or community experience, performance flyers/programs, and/or general references.
