Important information:

- Full-time study equates to 24 units per year.
- At the start of the year you must enrol in **BOTH** semester 1 and 2 courses as listed below. Mid-year entry students will only be able to enroll in Semester 2 courses.
- **Courses with both Part 1 and Part 2 must be taken in consecutive semesters.**
- Some courses may have Related Classes (e.g. Tutorials). Students will either be automatically enrolled in any of the Related Class/es or prompted to choose a Related Class/es.
